Session Descriptions

Using Echo for Staff Communication

How Echo can become a centralized place for your staff communication and learning? In this session, we will explore the different ways New Tech schools are using Echo for staff communication as well as to support staff learning.

Discussion will focus on how each tool can be used under a variety of circumstances to either inform school development (formative tools) or document outcomes for external audiences (summative tools and comparative data). This session will help leaders answer the common question, how and when do I use data from surveys?

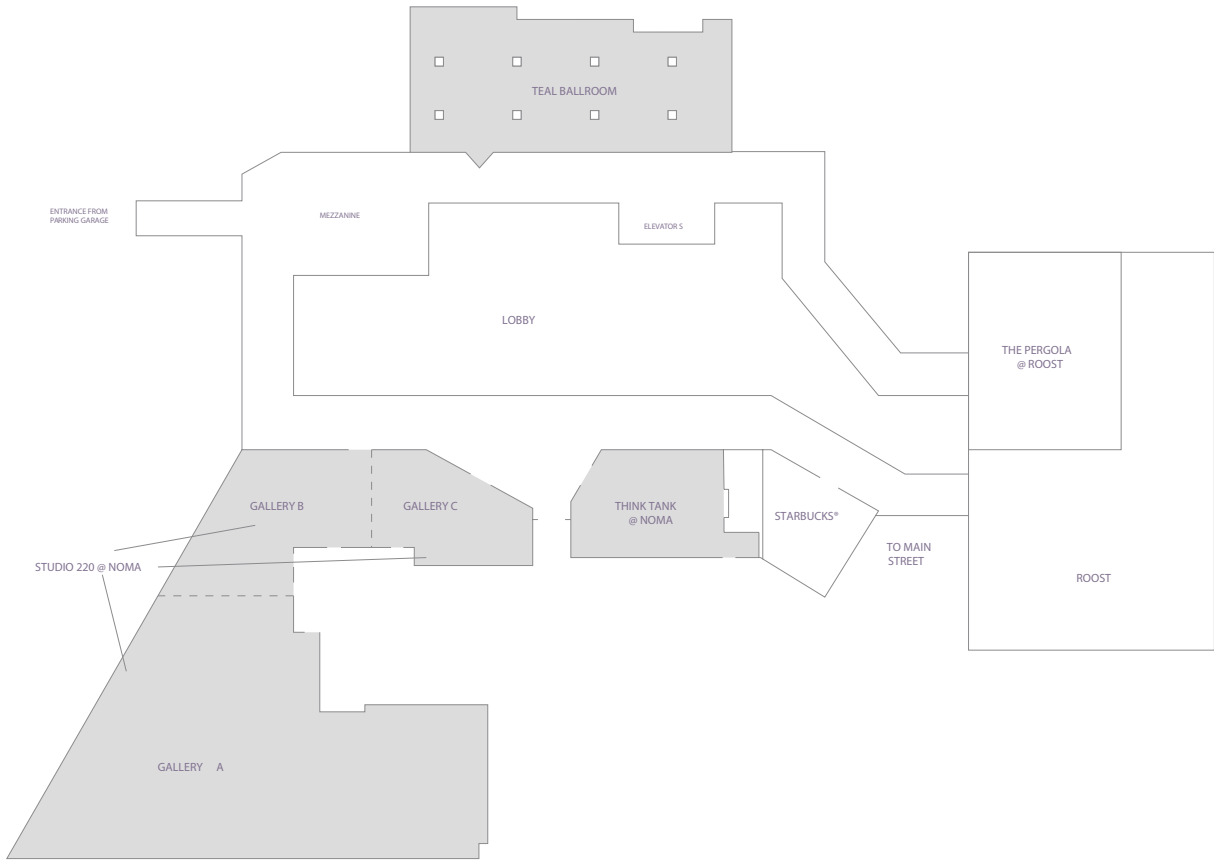
